Dear friends,

We are a little over a month into our participation in our Diocese's annual Partners in Charity Appeal, and you have certainly shown your generosity. As you recall, we started about a month later than the rest of the Diocese because there was so much going on during Lent through Easter, and I did not want to try to squeeze an important message about Partners in Charity in with these other critical messages and celebrations. So, I asked the Bishop personally face-to-face if we could have permission to start our campaign a month late, assuring him that it would result in more generous giving from the parishioners of St. Mary and St. Philip. He agreed.

Here is the update: **St. Mary has donated or pledged \$37,336.00 toward our \$67,800.00 goal, which is about 55% of the goal; St. Philp has donated or pledged \$16,630.00 toward our \$33,200.00 goal, which is about 51% of the goal.** So we are over the halfway point. This is great, and thank you. However, the phenomenon (and danger) at this point is that we will stall in mid-stream. Therefore, I remind us of all the wonderful works of mercy our generosity to the Appeal allows us to do for God and God's people.

The annual Appeal is such a powerful means for us to share the gifts God has bestowed on us with our Catholic Community here in Worcester County. This allows us to live our faith, help build God's kingdom and assist so many of Jesus' brothers and sisters with their various needs. Our generosity and stewardship help fund the work of 29 charitable, educational and pastoral ministries and help thousands of families through outreach, formation, evangelization and worship, including:

- Families which need a helping hand through Catholic Charities and Pernet Family Health Services
- Seminarians studying for the priesthood and candidates studying to be deacons to spend their lives helping and serving us
- Retired priests whom we can help after a lifetime of helping and serving us
- Catholic school students who otherwise could not fulfill their God-given potential with the benefit of a Catholic education
- Orphan boys who would not grow into the men God created them to be by living, working and studying at the McAuley Nazareth Home for Boys
- Pre-born children who have a right to life and their parents who are struggling to choose life with the benefit of the Respect Life Office
- Our Catholic brothers and sisters who struggle for the basic necessities of life in the Diocese of Les Cayes, Haiti, the poorest and most tortured country in the Western Hemisphere
- Our African and Latino Catholic brothers and sisters who are trying to assimilate into our culture with the benefit of worshipping in their own language with priests and religious who speak it and understand their culture of origin

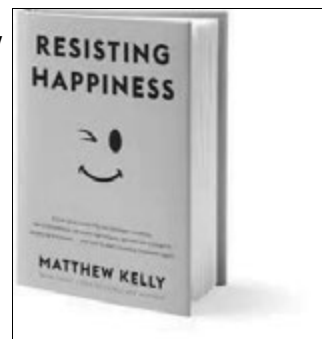

**New Message Series on *Resisting Happiness* is starting this weekend.** As we have a couple of times before, we gave as a gift to folks who came to Mass on Easter one of Matthew Kelly's books. This time it was his latest (and perhaps his best so far), *Resisting Happiness*. Originally from Australia, Kelly is an enormously successful Catholic writer who is a lay person, husband and father of young children. His books are a basic, powerful and inspirational re-presentation of the fundamental truths, traditions, practices and tools of the Catholic faith or, as Kelly puts it, "the genius of Catholicism". He has done so in other recent and popular books as *Rediscover Catholicism*, *Rediscover Jesus* and *Beautiful Mercy*. He is also the founder of The Dynamic Catholic Institute ([www.dynamiccatholic.com](http://www.dynamiccatholic.com)), whose mission is to re-energize the Catholic Church in America by developing resources which inspire people to rediscover the genius of Catholicism.



In *Resisting Happiness*, Kelly talks about the reality of "resistance", which, in more traditional and obscure theological language, would be called "the effects of Original Sin". Specifically, Kelly defines resistance as "that sluggish feeling of not wanting to do something that you know is good for you, it's the inclination to do something that you unabashedly know is *not* good for you, and it's everything in between". In essence, we all have a tendency to resist the will of God when embracing God's will is the only real path to happiness because God IS happiness. And Kelly presents the fundamental truths, traditions, practices and tools to learn to overcome resistance.

This Sunday's first installment of the message series is called, appropriately enough, "Thy Will Be Done". It is still possible to join one of the small faith-sharing groups which meet during the week to continue the discussion the preacher begins with the homily. Meeting times (most at St. Mary church) are on Sunday, Wednesday and Saturday mornings and Wednesday evenings.
